Before you Begin

Requirments

- Sketch (59) or higher
- MacOS High Sierra (10.13.4) or higher

Typography

Fabrx uses “Roboto” as it’s primary font, Roboto is a free Google Font included in your downloaded folder.

To install the Roboto font, double click the Roboto.zip file to extract it then open any of the .ttf files and click install font. Alternitavely, you can go to your mac apps folder, open the “Font Book” app and drag all .ttf files in the “All Fonts, Computer or User” tab according to your pereference.

01 Cover

When adding Fabrx as a library, the icon in the cover page will be set as your library's cover image. To achieve that make sure you save the Sketch file while the cover page is active.

02 Style Guide

Is where you can customize all colors and typography.

Colors: After changing colors, go to the APPEARANCE menu and select update layer styles for your changes to take effect.

Typography: After changing fonts or font colors, go to the APPEARANCE menu and select update text styles for your changes to take effect.

Tip: To change all fonts, hold CMD + Shift and drag to select all text layers, from the right TEXT menu, change the font to a different one, after that update text styles to see your changes.

03 Components

Is a full preview of elements used in Fabrx. Feel free to copy and paste any of the components to your artboard and experiment with them.

04 Layouts

Here you can find the layouts library. Start building your project by simply copying and pasting layouts to your project's artboard. You can resize widgets vertically and horizontally, this will make it easier for layouts to snap together.

05 Charts & Data

A collection of common chart styles, tables and data cards.

06 Symbols

This is the heart of Fabrx, Symbols allows you to reuse elements easily across your project. If you need to make a radical change to any of the components, double click it, make your changes and it will show anywhere this component is used.

07 Overrides

You can easily customize component colors, icons, typography and other parameters directly after clicking it through the overrides menu on the right. Changing any of those parameters will not affect the master symbol.
